Nature & Garden Club News

If there was any doubt...summer is here!!

We did receive plenty of rain but no hail damage like they had in Omaha and Ralston.

Gardens are now flourishing and vegetables will be harvesting soon.

Gardening Tip:

Apply sunscreen generously before going outdoors. It takes approximately 15 minutes for your skin to absorb the sunscreen and protect you. If you wait until you are in the sun to apply sunscreen your skin is actually unprotected and can burn. To remain protected, reapply every two hours

Although summer has only just begun, we've already had long spells of hot weather. This can take its toll on flowering annuals. Blooms may not last as long in cooler weather so keep an eye on them and remove the flower heads when their luster has passed – before seeds have a chance to form. This will extend the blooming period for flowering annuals.

Another trick that helps to maintain the full, lush appearance of your annuals is to cut the foliage back to its original height when plants start to become leggy or when blooms seem to slow.

Whether or not your plants need trimming, it's important to fertilize your plants every 1-3 weeks. The hotter the weather, the more frequently the annuals will need supplemental feedings. Water-soluble fertilizer works well. If your plants need to be cut back, it is best to do so just before fertilizing them.

These tricks can keep your annuals blooming well into the fall.

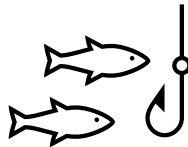
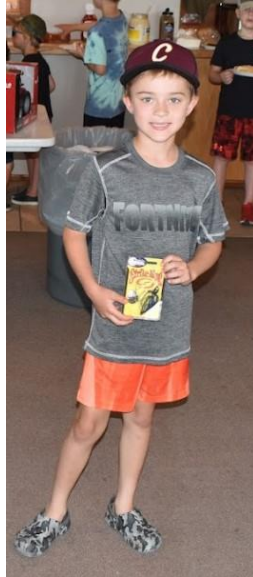
